Jane and her husband, Steve, served as Board Members since the Foundation's inception in 2006.

A child's terminal illness changes a parent's life forever. With the death of her beloved son, Stephen, Jane, her husband and the entire Comunale family set out to positively change the lives of children and parents dealing with the challenges of cancer.

For many, the loss is incapacitating. Despite the magnitude of her loss, Jane found the strength to use her son's death as an inspiration. The Foundation has continued to honor the memory of Stephen A. Comunale, Jr. as well as his aunt, Amy Comunale Klein. Jane would spend an entire year planning every detail of THE EVENT, our signature benefit that supports our Foundation's giving.

Every individual's circumstances differ and so do their needs. The Foundation's mission is to react quickly to alleviate a family's day-to-day financial burdens. Jane used her loss to make a better future for others. The Foundation gives hope, support, and a helping hand to satisfy basic needs in order to allow families to fight cancer and live in a better present.

Jane taught those that knew her about love,

laughter, and loss. By example, she taught a community how to lose what you love most in the world and yet continue to forge a better future for others.

On a personal note, I more than anyone owe a large debt of gratitude to our Jane. It was Jane, with Steve's help, who changed my life forever when she introduced me to my wife Dee Dee. The four of us were in each other's weddings, took disco lessons together in the 80's, and were there for each other as we dealt with tragedy.

For five years, the Foundation was Jane's passion. We will continue to be a source of support for families on the cancer

Foundation Programs Are Stronger Than Ever & Touching More Lives!


Individual Grant Giving: A program offered every week of the year! As of October 15, 2011, 153 grants of financial assistance have been provided to local individuals and families in our community who are battling a cancer diagnosis this year. A year ago, 104 grants had been provided local individuals and families. The Foundation will continue to be a source of hope and support, and we certainly hope to share with you again in 2012 that the Foundation has been able to continue helping even more individuals and families than ever before.

Horses were a true passion of Stephen's, so it is now part of the Foundation's mission to share that same love of horses with many other children to help foster their growth and development.



2011 Back-to-School with Confidence Program:

In early August 2011, the Foundation provided 47 local children touched by cancer with new IVAR backpacks, school supplies and Payless Shoe Source gift cards. We were able to assist 17 more children this year, and we hope to increase the number of children that we can help in 2012!


